

## **PROF. ASLI SENCER**

### **BIOGRAPHY**

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Prof. Aslı Sencer is a faculty member in the Department of Management Information Systems at Boğaziçi University, Istanbul, Türkiye. She obtained her bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees in Industrial Engineering.

Prof. Sencer's recent research has progressed from the development of digital maturity models, to investigating digital transformation for sustainable supply chain management, and most recently to developing developmental capability assessment frameworks for AI-enabled processes.

In parallel with her research, she teaches courses on business intelligence, digital transformation, supply chain management, analytical decision making, and business process management, for which she has received awards recognizing her outstanding teaching performance.

Believing that theory and practice should go hand in hand, she has delivered executive training programs for more than 20 leading companies across over 10 industries.

Prof. Sencer has also led professional projects and served in various professional organizations. She is a Professional Associate of AZCA Inc. (California, USA) and has served on the Advisory Board of International Data Corporation (IDC) Türkiye. During the COVID-19 pandemic, she supervised the Digital Transformation (DX) Survey in Japan in collaboration with AZCA Inc. to examine the progress of digital transformation in Japanese companies and assess the impact of the pandemic.

In June 2016, she co-chaired the 24th European Conference on Information Systems (ECIS) in Istanbul. She also co-chaired the ECIS–CIO Symposium, which brought together 15 CIOs from leading international and Turkish companies. In Fall 2018, she spent her sabbatical as a Visiting Professor in the Department of Industrial Engineering at Northeastern University, Boston. Prof. Sencer is a founding member and former President of the Turkey Chapter of the Association for Information Systems (AIS), the world's largest professional association in the field of Management Information Systems.
