

Bilgin Metin is a professor in the Management Information Systems Dept. at Boğaziçi University, where he served as department head between 2022 and 2026. His research focuses on cybersecurity, IT/AI/privacy governance, IT risk management, human factors in information security, and information communication technology design. Prof. Metin has authored over 130 publications and has an h-index of 27 on Google Scholar.

He serves as an Associate Editor for the Journal of Cyber Security Technology (Taylor & Francis), and he is on the editorial boards of several prestigious journals, such as Information Security Journal: A Global Perspective (Taylor & Francis), EDPACS (EDP Audit, Control, and Security Newsletter) (Taylor & Francis), and International Journal of Information Security and Privacy (IGI Global), and Organizational Cybersecurity Journal: Practice, Process, and People (Emerald).

Highlighting his hands-on technical expertise, Prof. Metin holds distinguished industry certifications, including Certified Ethical Hacker (CEH), Offensive Security Certified Professional (OSCP), Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), Certified Data Privacy Solutions Engineer (CDPSE), and ISO 27001 Lead Auditor.

He served as the program chair for the AIS-affiliated CONF-IRM 2025 conference and as a local co-chair for ECIS 2016 (European Conference on Information Systems) of AIS. He has also been a track chair for numerous other international conferences.

Prof. Metin served as the program chair for the AIS-affiliated CONF-IRM 2025 conference. He also acted as the project coordinator at Boğaziçi University for various EU projects. One completed EU Erasmus+ funded project is "RECYPHER: Rethinking Cybersecurity in Pakistan: The Essential Role of Human Factors" (2021–2025), which involved a partnership among Germany, Turkey, and Pakistan. In 2026, he started the EU Horizon-funded project WEM-CYBER (Widening Excellence and Mentoring in Cybersecurity).

Since 2021, Prof. Bilgin Metin has been listed among the World's Top 2% Scientists by Stanford University and Elsevier. He is the founding director of the Boğaziçi University MIS Cybersecurity Center (since 2017), and he has been the manager of the Information System Research Center since 2026.
